**Conditions for candidate entry:**

- Student is an editor of the 2011/12 school yearbook.
- Student is in Grade 12 and going post-secondary in 2012/13 to an accredited institution.
- School is submitting their 2011/12 book to the Canadian Yearbook Review for a review.
- Student has offered volunteer services to the local community.
- Student has completed all requirements for a high school diploma in the 2011/12 school term.

**Criteria for selecting winning candidate:**

- Outstanding scholastic achievement
- Involvement in volunteer community service
- An exceptional editor of the current school yearbook

**Scholarship deadlines:**

- Entries must be received by October 31, 2012.
- Winning candidate announcement by November 15, 2012.

**General scholarship information:**

The Canadian Yearbook Review is offering a scholastic scholarship of \$500.00 to an editor of a Canadian school yearbook for the 2011/12 term. The scholarship will be awarded to the top candidate of all entries received.

Entrants must submit the following:

- a transcript of their Grade X11 marks.
- a letter of reference from their school yearbook advisor.
- a letter of reference from a community organization where the candidate has provided volunteer services.
- an admissions acceptance letter from an accredited post-secondary educational institution.
- a letter from the applicant outlining the directions they are taking with further education and future employment aspirations.
- a completed scholarship application form.

Letters of reference must be on letterhead stationery of the supporting school and community organization.

The intent of the \$500.00 Canadian Yearbook Review scholarship is to recognize the efforts of students taking leadership roles in the community and school yearbook production. Funds are intended to provide assistance to post-secondary education and encourage further studies.
